











The active Migration caseload is up 42% compared to the 11,329 cases that were on hand as at the same time last year. The active Refugee caseload is up 54% compared to the 5,437 cases that were on hand as at the same time last year.

As at 30 June 2017, 2,175 Migration cases (14%) were over 365 days old and 5,478 Refugee cases (65%) were over 90 days old.
