



# COVID-19 declaration form for visitors to the AAT

The AAT has a COVID-safe plan in place to protect the health and safety of our people, visitors, and the wider community, and we ask that you complete this form before you visit one of the AAT’s registries. If you return the form to us in advance of attending, you may also be asked to complete the form again when you arrive at the AAT. We may ask you to leave the building if you do not complete this form.

If you are visiting the AAT in **Melbourne or Sydney**, the AAT requires that you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or have a certified medical exemption. Please be aware that your hearing will not proceed if you cannot provide evidence of your vaccination status or a valid medical exemption on arrival.

By signing this form, I confirm that the following statements are true:

- I am not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, such as fever, a cough, sore/scratchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of smell or loss of taste.
- To the best of my knowledge, I am not required to quarantine or self-isolate for any reason, including:
  - testing positive to COVID-19 or being suspected of having COVID-19
  - being in close contact in the last 14 days with a person who is a confirmed case of COVID-19, including having visited an identified case location\* where COVID-19 was detected
  - being a household member of a close contact, and the close contact is yet to receive their initial negative test result
  - not yet receiving a negative test result after being identified as a casual contact in the last 14 days with a person who is a confirmed case of COVID-19, including having visited an identified case location\*
  - not yet receiving a negative test result after visiting a known COVID-19 hotspot\* in the last 14 days
  - not yet receiving a negative test result after being tested for COVID-19.
- On arrival at the AAT, I will/have checked-in using the authorised local check-in system and provide proof that I am fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if required by relevant State or Territory Public Health Orders.
